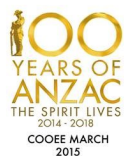

You may have noticed a sign on the front fence mentioning Gonski funding. Under the Gonski plan, all schools receive additional funding according to the individual needs of their students. Schools can use the additional resources to better meet the individual needs of students.

Five state and territory governments in 2013 signed agreements with the Federal Government to follow the Gonski plan and improve the way schools are resourced. Those agreements specify the level of funding each government must contribute over six years from 2014 to get to a point where all schools have the right level of resources. At Lue PS, we have used the funding to provide additional resources and opportunities for students and professional development for staff to ensure quality teaching and learning. ### Bar Fridge For Sale

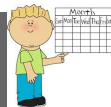
We have a small bar fridge at school that we no longer require and are offering it for sale at \$100. Please contact us at school if you are interested.
