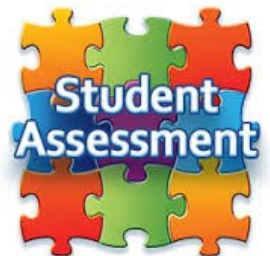
Catch me being good

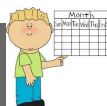
