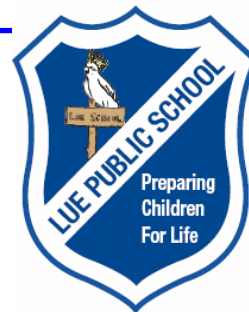

Use internet sites wisely



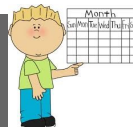
