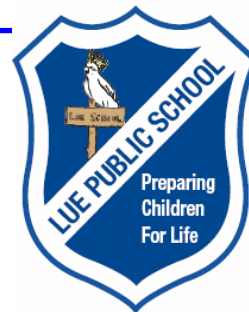

Give your best effort at all times



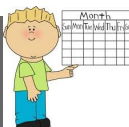
