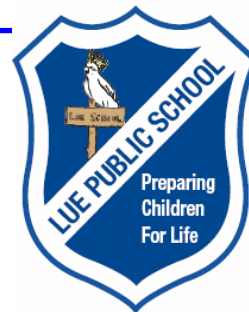

**For students who live in the Lue area, there will be no school bus in the morning. Those students should be at school by 7:50am.**

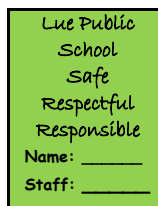
**For students who travel from the Kandos/ Rylstone area, the school bus will pick up as usual at the normal time and meet us in Rylstone on our way through.**

A timetable with the student speaking times has been attached to this newsletter. Students must be in full school uniform and will require a packed lunch, recess and a filled water bottle for the day.

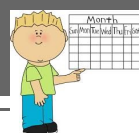
Your child has been given a copy of their speech to practise. Please support them by listening while they practise their speeches at home.
