Students are being reminded about our key words, **safe**, **respectful** and **responsible**, before they enter the classroom and before they go out for recess and lunch.

Our students were reminded at every opportunity about the appropriate behaviour for lining up and entering the classroom. Students have been quick to stop talking when lining up and show that they are listening to the teacher. This supports them in having the right mindset for learning when entering the classroom. It ensures that maximum time is spent on learning and not on dealing with behaviour issues.

This week we will continue to focus on this area and reward students who demonstrate the appropriate behaviour with green slips.

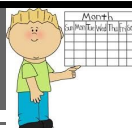
