**Elijah** receives a \$4 voucher for the canteen lunch tomorrow & each student will receive a merit certificate and a milo at lunch.

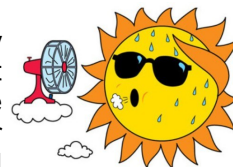

Our 'student of the week' this week is **Natasha Panschow**. Natasha tries hard to **follow the rules** and helps others to do the same.

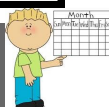


#### Junior Class Busy Bee
