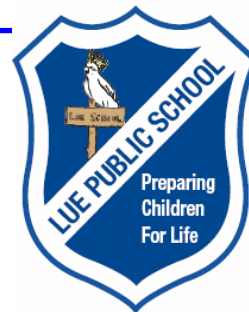

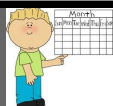
Junior Class Busy Bee
